Fees
If there is no connection point available on Council's sewer line...

The applicant will be required to pay an installation fee of **\$450 per connection**. The installation fee is for residential properties and includes the installation of a 'y' Junction (connection) onto Council's sewer line.

Once the junction has been constructed there will be **an additional fee of \$200** for Council's Engineer to inspect and approve the private drain connection before the trench is filled in. Failure to do so may result in immediate disconnection at the applicants cost.

If a 'y' junction of connection already exists...

With Council's permission, the applicant may use a registered plumber or drain layer to connect into Council's sewer line.

Once again a fee of \$200 applies for the work to be inspected by Council's Engineer before the trench is filled.

Conditions:

- 1 The applicant will pay all costs associated with laying and connecting the sewer line from their property to Council's sewer main. In the event that the nearest Council line is in or across the road or footpath but not in adjacent property, Council may do the work. Council will forward the cost estimate to the applicant, or with Council approval, the work may be done by a registered drain layer at the applicant's cost. Payment must be made before work begins.
- 2 If the work is to be done by the applicant the applicant must provide an approved Traffic Management Plan for all works carried out along side or across a road or footpath.
- 3 A wastewater connection can only be made into a public sewer. Connecting to other pipes are prohibited.
- 4 No connection shall be made to any sewer by a private individual.
- 5 Council's Engineer requires at least 24 hours notice for any inspection. The Engineer must also be notified before any work on or along side a road or footpath may commence.
- 6 Any damage caused to footpaths, roads or berms during the works shall be reinstated to Council's satisfaction or will be repaired by Council at the applicant's expense.
- 7 Any connection greater than 100 mm diameter must have the Council Engineer's prior approval for connection to a manhole.
- 8 Once completed the applicant will be responsible for the ongoing maintenance of the line between the property and the connection on the Council sewer line.
