We are property owners of lot17 108 Manu Drive within the Takahoa Bay subdivision.

We strongly object to the proposed zone change on the basis that increased residential population would have an adverse effect on the environment and possible further contamination of the Kaipara Harbour from sewage waste.

Further to the above, Oneriri Road is barely coping with existing traffic movements at the moment. There is a one lane bridge that is suspect to flooding which could potentially be life threatening if emergency vehicles are unable to access in times of crisis.

The access into and from State highway one is another potentially dangerous situation. With an increase in traffic volume the risk to life is further increased.
