We have little infrastructure in Hinamoki Estate 6km down Oneriri Road.Poor roading, one lane bridge prone to flooding,no public transport (except school bus), unsuitable roads for existing logging and stock trucks. Hinamoki Estate has only community provision for existing lots for roading, community sewage and storm water. We have to provide own water and sewerage. Only rubbish and postal services on Oneriri Road despite Hinamoki Drive being 3-4km long. Difficult access to main highway from Oneriri Road at peak traffic already exists.
