The submission point does not specifically identify properties in particular, but I presume it refers to the rural lifestyle zoned land on the western side of Oneriri Road. The zoning reflects land use. In this location, the existing subdivision pattern is not characterised with large commercial farms, but a large number of rural lifestyle blocks. I disagree that an additional layering of rules is needed here. When designing a subdivision, the sizing of lots comes down to numerous factors such as stable building sites, the ability to appropriately access and service the block, and privacy and amenity. This means that often, the minimum lot size cannot be attained. Effects of a development on surrounding elements such as traffic systems depend on factors such as the scale of the development (how many additional sites are being created) and the layout (eg where will an access point sit)

I am a land surveyor who has undertaken subdivision development in the Kaipara District for over thirty years. While fibre is a very good telecommunications system, it is not the only one. Cellular and wireless systems provide adequate telecommunications for new lots created in some circumstances. The intended land use also dictates whether a telecommunications connection is required. (eg pine trees or livestock do not need to call their relatives). Not every block of land being created is going to become another oversized residential site. The use of the publicly available coverage maps for cellular telecommunications should be sufficient evidence as to whether or not a site can receive telecommunications service. I do not see the need to increase delay and paperwork by having to write to a telecommunications provider to see whether they can or will provide a service, then wait for their reply. Subdivision and development is such a complex and expensive process in terms of both time and cost. We should not be seeking to increase complexity, timeframes and costs. Please set rules in place that do the opposite.

Before imposing any need to connect to fibre, there should be publicly available clear and up to date mapping as to where a service exists. There also needs to be a clear and very efficient means to collaborate with the telco so that telecommunications provision in a subdivision that actually

needs it is a seamless and efficient process.

We need to get away from rules in a district plan requiring connection to a network, like the outdated ones we currently have requiring connections to the copper network. The rules need to be technology independent. I want rules that are workable and responsive. I'm tired of years of trying to put square pegs in round holes when trying to efficiently develop property.
