While I'm not opposed to increasing indigenous vegetation cover as such, this needs to take account of various factors such as the nature of soils etc so that land suitable for productive use can be so used, and land that is not so productive, or has various constraints can be areas promoted for such enhancement. Perhaps a land use/ ecological enhancement offsetting system could help here. Care also needs to be taken that fire risk is considered when establishing or enhancing indigenous vegetation areas. Certain areas might be more prone to fire risk. Think of the damaged trailer trailing showers of sparks alongside the State Highway in the central plateau, and the disastrous consequences of that. Inappropriately positioned indigenous vegetation could lead to massive destruction of a valuable ecological resource.

While I have said oppose, I have a suggestion that may help in the interim. I think that it would be best to complete the Proposed Plan as best as possible for now. Central government has signalled change in this area, but Forest & Bird wants to ensure that there are suitable protections for our district. As an interim measure we could adopt the mapping for the ONLs that sit in the operative District Plan. These areas are there after the reasonably rigorous process undertaken to create the Operative Plan. Sure they relate to landscape, but I think they are also ecologically significant. A plan change could

follow once central government direction is known.

Care needs to be taken that landowners are not turned away from the good work is being done on private land through organisation like KMR. If the district plan gets too heavy handed on property rights, landowners may get gun-shy about undertaking ecological enhancements of their properties, and this might be detrimental overall to ecosystems and indigenous biodiversity in our district. I contend that private enhancements have a greater potential to establish a better connected network of ecological corridors across the district, than to simply lock up what is perceived a significant natural area on a property. Taking a long view is more likely to benefit the ecosystems and indigenous biodiversity of the district..

I am a surveyor with over 30 years experience operating in the Kaipara District. I oppose the removal of the words offset or compensate in relation to subdivision, land use & development. When undertaking these activities there are numerous factors that go into the design. The art comes in the balancing and weighing between the various factors. While it is not always so, I have found that a certain place might be clad in indigenous vegetation, but the land is of a much better usability than other land in the property involved. It might prove the best long-term outcome to develop the land better suited for this purpose, and to establish a well considered replacement ecological enhancement area. This might adjoin other areas of ecological significance providing ecological corridors, or it might provide a better outcome for erosion prone land and/or water quality, or it might provide a better outcome for the protection of elite soils. It can be short sighted to simply protect everything as it is. The forested area might be forested because it was owned by someone who did

not have the resources at the appropriate time in the land's history to clear the land with bulldozer and fire, and the land alongside was owned by someone who did. The fact that the clear land is covered in slips, is putting sediment in the Kaipara Harbour and provides potential to create an ecological corridor between more significant areas of biodiversity should be able to be used as an offsetting for clearing an area of sparse indigenous remnant that has a bad weed problem.
