We write in support of all submissions that ask that KDC adopt the precautionary and prohibitive GE/GMO provisions, policies and rules that KDC itself proposed in the KDC Exposure draft a few years ago (which received overwhelming support from Kaipara ratepayers and other Northlanders).

Today the inclusion of the precautionary and prohibitive GE/GMO provisions, policies and rules are even more important as basic protections under the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms (HSNO) Act are threatened by the controversial, impractical, and dangerous Gene Technology Bill.

We support submitters who have proposed to amend and add the provisions, policies and rules for Genetic Engineering/Genetically Modified Organisms into the Kaipara District Council proposed District Plan, consistent with the wording contained in the operative Northland "Regional Policy Statement" and Northland "Regional Plan".as well as what Far North District Council, Whangarei District Council and Auckland Council have achieved in their operative plans.

KDC was a formative member of the Northland/ Auckland ICWP on GMOs (along with Whangarei District Council) and the excellent, fiscally responsible, and collaborative work of all the councils to address the significant risks of outdoor GE/GMOs and should continue on this path.
