The definition does not cover reflective surfaces which can cause significant changes to natural environments, in particular renewable energy sources, mainly solar panels. Not covering this allows broader scope for investment and renewable infrastructure on a larger scale, this will also leave the interpretation of visual pollution very open.
117.11	G Moore	Light	Amend	AMEND LIGHT-R1 to include reflection/glare of solar panels to the light guidelines.	No reason provided; however the submission is concerned about glare and mentions that reflective surfaces can cause significant changes to natural environments.

The submitter supports LIGHT-R1 in part. It is noted that LIGHT-P1, clause 2 specifically notes the security aspect of lighting. While security is an aspect of health and safety, the Council should amend clause 3.c to be consistent with LIGHT-P1.
149.96	Royal Forest and Bird Protection Society of New Zealand Incorporated	Light	Amend	ADD the following text to the Overview in the Light chapter: Artificial lighting, including spill and glare, can negatively affect indigenous biodiversity by disrupting natural patterns and behaviours. For example, excessive night lighting can interfere with the movement and feeding of nocturnal insects, which in turn affects species that rely on them for food. AND Any consequential amendments and alternative relief to address the concerns raised.	As drafted, the Light Overview does not reflect the potential adverse effects of light on natural environment values.

AND Any consequential amendments and alternative relief to address the concerns raised.	As drafted, LIGHT-P2 does not reflect the potential adverse effects of light on natural environment values.

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149.99	Royal Forest and Bird Protection Society of New Zealand Incorporated	Light	Amend	ADD an additional standard to LIGHT-R1.a. for artificial outdoor lighting within the Coastal Environment, Outstanding Natural Features and Landscapes, and areas containing indigenous biodiversity to avoid adverse effects of lighting on indigenous biodiversity. AND ADD the following matters of discretion to the new LIGHT-R1 standard: • The effect of the light on indigenous biodiversity values • The extent of light and any practicable locations or methods to avoid or reduce the extent of effects on indigenous biodiversity values • The proposed measures to avoid, remedy, mitigate, offset or compensate adverse effects on indigenous biodiversity values AND Any consequential amendments and alternative relief to address the concerns raised.	As drafted, LIGHT-R1 does not reflect the potential adverse effects of light on natural environment values.

The submitter considers that intrusive lighting can result in adverse effects on the environment, including ecosystems and constituent parts, people and communities, all natural and physical resources, and amenity values. The Light Chapter does not provide for protection from intrusive lighting effects as outlined in LIGHT-P1. As such, the provision sought will provide LIGHT-P1 with a clear objective.
