## **Decision (On the Papers)**

This is an application for the issuing of a Managers Certificate to Rosslyn Manuera.

The District Licensing Committee notes that the applicant is working in the premises known as Blah Blah, 101 Victoria Street, Dargaville, Kaipara District.

This application was made under s.219 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and determined by the District Licencing Committee under s. 221 of the Act.

The application was referred to the Police and Licencing Inspector for comment.



Police raised concerns with regard to the suitability of the applicant to hold a certificate. These concerns were subsequently resolved after a joint agency interview.

- The applicant has agreed to live in Dargaville rather than Ruawai for an interim period to enable her walking access to her current place of employment.
- To enable her to gain further experience within the hospitability industry, she has also provided
  a written undertaking to work as a duty manager at her current place of employment for the
  first probationary year.

No further objections to the granting of a manager's certificate have been received.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.220 and 222 of the Act and we grant the issuing of a Managers certificate under s.202(1) and subject to the applicants written undertaking.

The Certificate may be issued immediately.
