Decision (From the Hearing)

This is an application for the issuing of a Managers Certificate to Paul Jeffrey Greig.

The District Licensing Committee notes that the applicant is working in the premises known as Three Furlongs Bar and Grill, 1942 State Highway One, Kaiwaka, Kaipara District.

This application was made under s.219 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and determined by the District Licensing Committee under s. 221 of the Act.



The application was referred to the Police and Inspector for comment. The Police opposed the application for a manager's certificate as a result of a failed Controlled Purchase Operation conducted on 04 September 2015 where the duty manager sold to a minor. The application for suspension of the duty manager's certificate is currently before the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority.

It has been determined that the applicant was not the duty manager, or working within the premises at the time of the failed Controlled Purchase Operation, therefore it is considered that it would be unfair to the applicant to prejudice and decline this application. Mr Greig has completed relevant training; had sufficient experience, and has demonstrated an understanding of the object of the Act with regard to the minimisations of all potential harm caused by excessive or inappropriate consumption of alcohol.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in ss.220 and 222 of the Act and we grant the issuing of a Managers certificate under s.202(3) of the Act.

The certificate may issue immediately.
