Decision (On the Papers)

This is for an application for the renewal of an On licence to Sheryl Yvonne Harrison and Keary Russell Stuart situated at 3090 State Highway 14, Tangiteroria, Kaipara District known as "Tangiteroria Tavern".

These applications were made under s.127 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and determined by the District Licensing Committee under s.130 of the Act.

No objections or notice of desire to be heard have been received by the Police, the Medical Officer Health, the Licensing Inspector nor the general public.

The application was filed with the Territorial Authority on 18 July 2014, but not able to be progressed to the District Licensing Committee for determination until all further information requests had been provided by the applicant. These requests were not fulfilled until July 2015.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in ss.105 and 131 of the Act and we grant the renewal of the On licence under s.202(1).

The existing licence is deemed to be current under s.122 of the Act.

We renew the On licence until 20 July 2017 pursuant to s.135(1) of the Act, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most current date of expiry and authorise the issue of a replacement licence and a notice of renewal.

The licensee's attention is drawn to condition (c) of replacement licence 03/ON/013/2015 to ensure that drinking water is readily available and free of charge to customers at all times that the licensed premises are open for business. Signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.
