**Decision (On the Papers)**

This is for an application by Todd Andrew Skudder on behalf of the Dargaville Vet Centre for a Special licence in respect of premises situated at 37 Hokianga Road, Dargaville, Kaipara District and known as the Dargaville Town Hall. The application is for the Farmers Fashion Show to be held on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> October 2015 from 6.00pm to 9.00pm.

This application was made under section 138 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and is being determined by the District Licencing Committee under section 191(2).

The application was referred to the Police, Medical Officer of Health and Inspector for comment. No matters in opposition have been raised in respect of the applicant.



We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act and we grant the applicant a Special Licence.

Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:

- **Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> October 2015 from 6.00pm to 9.00pm.**


The licence will be subject to the following conditions:

- a) The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments.
- b) A variety of substantial foods shall be available as detailed by the applicant for consumption on the premises at all times when the premises are authorised to be open for the sale and supply of alcohol. The range of food will include toasted bread pockets with smoked fish, kumara and bacon chowder, beef burgers, lamb curry and a choice of desserts.
- c) Low-alcohol beverages of the nature stated on the application form, must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times when the premises are authorised to be open for the sale of alcohol.
- d) Drinking water must be readily available and free of charge.
- e) The steps detailed in the application form must be taken by the licensee to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the licensed premises.
- f) The steps as detailed in the application form must be taken by the licensee to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol.
- g) The following steps shall be taken by the licensee to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - The Manager to be on duty at all times.
  - Host responsibility techniques to be applied to ensure no intoxication.
  - No sale of alcohol to minors or intoxicated persons allowed.
- h) Members of the public shall be excluded from the premises in the following circumstances:
  - If an intoxicated or otherwise prohibited person under the Act.



- i) Alcohol may only be served in the following containers:
- Beer shall be by way of beer handles or single serve 330ml bottles.
  - Wine shall be by way of single serve glassware as supplied by the premises.
