Decision (On the Papers)

This is for an application by Erin Rochelle Wilson-Collins on behalf of Dargaville Little Theatre for a Special licence in respect of premises situated at 241 Victoria Street, Dargaville, Kaipara District and known as the Dargaville Little Theatre. The application is for the Dargaville Little Theatre show series: "Material Girls: Together Again" to be held on the days, dates and times as detailed in the application.

This application was made under section 138 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and is being determined by the District Licencing Committee under section 191(2).

The application was referred to the Police, Medical Officer of Health and Inspector for comment. No matters in opposition have been raised in respect of the applicant.





We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act and we grant the applicant a Special Licence.

Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:

- · Saturday 03 October 2015 from 6.30pm to 11.00pm.
- · Thursday 08 October 2015 from 7.00pm to 11.00pm.
- · Friday 09 October 2015 from 7.00pm to 11.00pm.
- · Saturday 10 October 2015 from 7.00pm to 11.00pm
- Sunday 11 October 2015 from 3.00pm to 6.00pm
- · Friday 16 October 2015 from 7.00pm to 11.00pm
- · Saturday 17 October 2015 from 3.00pm to 6.00pm
- · Saturday 17 October 2015 from 7.00pm to 11.00pm

The licence will be subject to the following conditions:

- a) The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments.
- b) A variety of substantial foods shall be available as detailed by the applicant for consumption on the premises at all times when the premises are authorised to be open for the sale and supply of alcohol. The range of food will include savouries, sandwiches, samosas, spring rolls, eclairs, cakes and muffins.
- c) Low-alcohol beverages of the nature stated on the application form, must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times when the premises are authorised to be open for the sale of alcohol.
- d) Drinking water must be readily available and free of charge.
- e) The steps detailed in the application form must be taken by the licensee to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the licensed premises.
- f) The steps as detailed in the application form must be taken by the licensee to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol.





- g) The following steps shall be taken by the licensee to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - The Managers to be on duty at all times.
 - Host responsibility techniques to be applied to ensure no intoxication.
 - No sale of alcohol to minors or intoxicated persons allowed.
- h) Members of the public shall be excluded from the premises in the following circumstances:
 - If an intoxicated or otherwise prohibited person under the Act.
- i) Alcohol may only be served in the following containers:
 - Beer shall be by way of beer handles or single serve 330ml bottles.
 - Wine shall be by way of single serve glassware as supplied by the premises.
