Decision (On the Papers)

This is an application for the renewal of a Club licence to The Southern (Te Kopuru) Football Club Incorporated situated at Pouto Road, Te Kopuru, Kaipara District, known as "Southern (Te Kopuru) Football Club".

This application was made under s.127 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and determined by the District Licencing Committee under s.130 of the Act.

There are no changes sought to the conditions of the existing licence.

The application was referred to the Police, the Medical Officer of Health and Inspector for comment.

No matters in opposition have been raised in respect of the applicant.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in ss.105 and 131 of the Act and we grant the renewal of the Club licence under s.202(1).



We renew the licence until 20 March 2019 pursuant to s.135 (1) of the Act, that being the anniversary of the licence and three years from the most recent expiry and authorise the issue of a replacement licence and a notice of renewal.

The licensee's attention is drawn to condition (c) of replacement licence 03/CL/001/2016 to ensure that drinking water is readily available and free of charge to customers at all times that the licensed premises are open for business. Signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.
