**Decision (On the Papers)**

This is an application for the issuing of a Manager's Certificate to Ashley Harold Davenport.

The District Licensing Committee notes that the applicant is working in the premises known as Nolas Wines and Spirits, 128-130 Victoria Street, Dargaville, Kaipara District.

This application was made under s.219 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and determined by the District Licensing Committee under s. 221 of the Act.

The application was referred to the Police and Inspector for comment. No matters in opposition have been raised in respect of the applicant, although a recommendation for six months experience was made by the Inspector.



Section 220 and s.222 require the District Licencing Committee to consider all criteria when determining an application for a Managers Certificate. It is considered pursuant to s.222(c) that the applicant has limited experience with regard to working within a licensed premises.

The District Licencing Committee grants the issue of the Certificate once the applicant has completed six months supervised work experience within the licenced premises (ie not before 15 April 2016) as approved by the General Manager Planning and Regulatory.
