Decision (On the Papers)

This is for an application for the renewal of an Off licence to **Goblin Trading Limited, 2024 Paparoa Valley Road, Paparoa, Kaipara District** known as “Paparoa Store”.

This application was made under s.127 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and determined by the District Licencing Committee under s.130 of the Act.

There are no changes sought to the conditions of the existing licence.

The application was referred to the Police, the Medical Officer of Health and Inspector for comment. No matters in opposition have been raised in respect of the applicant.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and we grant the renewal of the Off licence under s.202(1).

The existing licence is deemed to be current under s.122 of the Act.



We renew the Off licence until 09 February 2019 pursuant to s.135(1) of the Act, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most current date of expiry and authorise the issue of a replacement licence and a notice of renewal.

The licensee's attention is drawn to condition (c) of replacement licence 03/OFF/003/2016 to ensure that drinking water is readily available and free of charge to customers at all times that the premises are offering complimentary tastings of alcohol. Signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.

The licensee's attention is drawn to s.56 and s.57 of the Act obliging the holder of the off-licence to display:

- (i) A sign to the exterior of the premises, so as to be easily read by persons outside each principal entrance, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for the sale of alcohol; and
- (ii) A copy of the licence, and of the conditions of the licence, attached to the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through each principal entrance; and
- (iii) A sign prominently displayed inside the premise, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
