We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in ss.105 and 131 of the Act and we grant the renewal of the Off licence under s.202(1).

The existing licence is deemed to be current under s.122 of the Act.

We renew the Off licence until 16 May 2019 pursuant to s.135(1) of the Act, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most current date of expiry and authorise the issue of a replacement licence and a notice of renewal.

The licensee's attention is drawn to condition (c) of replacement licence 03/OFF/007/2016 to ensure that potable drinking water is readily available and free of charge to customers at all times that the premises are offering complimentary tastings of alcohol. Signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.
