Decision (On the papers)

This is for an application dated 25 May 2016 by Somal & Sons Limited for an off-licence in respect of premises situated at 1923b State Highway 1, Kaiwaka, Kaipara District, known as “Kaiwaka Liquor Centre”.

The principal business proposed to be conducted under the licence is the operation of a bottle store.

The hours of trade sought in respect of this application are from Monday to Sunday, from 9.00 am to 10.00 pm.

This application was made under s.100 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and determined by the District Licencing Committee under s.104 of the Act.

The application was referred to the Police, the Medical Officer of Health and Inspector for comment. No matters in opposition have been raised in respect of the applicant.



We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in ss.105 and 106 of the Act and we grant the off-licence pursuant to s.202(1).

The licence may issue immediately.

The licensee's attention is drawn to condition (c) of licence 03/OFF/008/2016 to ensure that potable drinking water is readily available and free of charge to customers at all times that the premises are offering complimentary tastings of alcohol. Signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.

The licensee is reminded of their responsibilities with regard to the object of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
