Decision (on the papers)

This is an application for an On licence by Han Joong Kim, situated at 2 Moir Point Road, Mangawhai, Kaipara District and known as "Harvest Blue Cafe & Bistro".

Council's certificate was received on 08 August 2016 satisfying the requirement of s.100(f) of the Act proving compliance with the Resource Management Act 1991 and the Building Act 2004.

The application has been made under s.100 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and must be determined by the District Licencing Committee under s.104 of the Act.

The application was referred to the Police, the Medical Officer of Health and Licencing Inspector for comment. No matters in opposition have been raised in respect of the applicant.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act and we grant the On licence under s.202(1).

The licence may issue immediately.



The licensee's attention is also drawn to condition (d) of licence 03/ON/006/2016 to ensure that a potable drinking water supply is readily available and free of charge to customers at all times that the licensed premises are open for business. Signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.

The licensee's attention is drawn to s.56 and s.57 of the Act obliging the holder of the on-licence to display:

- (i) A sign to the exterior of the premises, so as to be easily read by persons outside each
 principal entrance, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be
 open for the sale of alcohol; and
- (ii) A copy of the licence, and of the conditions of the licence, attached to the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through each principal entrance; and
- (iii) A sign prominently displayed inside the premise, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.

The licensee is reminded of their responsibilities with regard to the object of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
