Decision (On the Papers)

This is an application for an On licence by JD Boys Venture Limited, situated at 40 Moir Street, Mangawhai, Kaipara District and known as "The Dune".

The applications were made under s.100 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and determined by the District Licencing Committee under s.104 of the Act.

The application was referred to the Police, the Medical Officer of Health and the Licencing Inspector for comment. No matters in opposition have been raised in respect of the applicant by the Police or the Medical officer of Health. The Inspector's report details the premises has been almost fully renovated, however a final inspection will not be possible until Monday 14 November 2016. No objection has been raised to the issuing of the licence subject to compliance with all signage displayed in accordance with the Act. The opening of the premises is scheduled for Wednesday 16 November 2016.
