Decision (On the Papers)

This is an application for On and Off Licences by Paparoa Hotel Limited, situated at 2039 Paparoa Valley Road, Paparoa, Kaipara District and known as "Paparoa Hotel".

The application was made under s.100 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and determined by the District Licencing Committee under s.104 of the Act.

The applications were referred to the Police, Licencing Inspector and the Medical Officer of Health for comment. The applications attracts no opposition from the reporting agencies in their final reports nor any objection from the public in general.

The licences are granted under s.202(1) of the Act and may issue immediately.


The licensee's attention is drawn to condition (c) of licences 03/ON/017/2016 and 03/OFF/013/2016 to ensure that drinking water is readily available and free of charge to customers at all times that the licensed premises are open for business, or when alcohol is being supplied free, as a complimentary sample. Signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.

The licensee's attention is also drawn to s.56 and s.57 of the Act obliging the holder of the On and Off Licences to display:

- (i) A sign to the exterior of the premises, so as to be easily read by persons outside each principal entrance, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for the sale of alcohol; and
- (ii) A copy of the licences, and of the conditions of the licences, attached to the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through each principal entrance; and
- (iii) A sign prominently displayed inside the premise, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.

The licensee is reminded of their responsibilities with regard to the object of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
