Decision (On the Papers)

This is for an application by Robin Thomas Weatherhog on behalf of the Maungaturoto Memorial RSA Incorporated for a Special licence in respect of premises situated at 115 Hurndall Street, Maungaturoto, Kaipara District and known as the Maungaturoto Memorial RSA. The application is for the ANZAC Day Dawn Parade, Breakfast and Commemorative Celebrations to be held on Monday 25 April 2016 from 6.00am until 10.00pm.

This application was made under section 138 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and is being determined by the District Licencing Committee under section 191(2).

The application was referred to the Police, Medical Officer of Health and Inspector for comment.

No matters in opposition have been raised in respect of the application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act and we grant the applicant a Special Licence.

In addition to Robin Thomas Weatherhog and Terence James McCook as Managers for the event, we also appoint under s.213(2) of the Act Naira Varney, Bruce Webster and Ross Needham as responsible persons for the occasion.

Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:

· Monday 25 April 2016 from 6.00am to 10.00pm.

The licence will be subject to the following conditions:

- a) The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments.
- b) A variety of substantial foods shall be available as detailed by the applicant for consumption on the premises at all times when the premises are authorised to be open for the sale and supply of alcohol. The range of food will include complimentary breakfast with a selection of sausages in bread, bacon and egg pie, savouries, sausage rolls and sandwiches. Brunch will include a selection of poached eggs, scrambled eggs, bacon, sausages, tomato and toast. Dinner will include a selection of sausages, egg, hot chips, scallops, seafood basket, pan fried fish, steak, chicken schnitzel, pork steak, potato salad, salad or coleslaw.
- c) Low-alcohol beverages of the nature stated on the application form, must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times when the premises are authorised to be open for the sale of alcohol.
- d) Potable drinking water is to be freely available to all customers at all times that the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol. 'Freely available' to customers, in relation to water, means -
 - (i) Supplied free in clean drinking vessels on request; or
 - (ii) Available free in larger containers from which it may be easily poured or drawn by customers, together with clean drinking vessels that are also available free nearby; or
 - (iii) Available free from a tap to which customers have easy access, together with clean drinking vessels that are also available free nearby.
- e) The steps detailed in the application form must be taken by the licensee to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the licensed premises.

f) The steps as detailed in the application form must be taken by the licensee to premote the responsible consumption of alcohol.

- g) The following steps shall be taken by the licensee to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - At least one certified Manager or one responsible person to be rostered on duty at all times.
 - Host responsibility techniques to be applied to ensure no intoxication.
 - No sale of alcohol to minors or intoxicated persons allowed.
- h) Members of the public shall be excluded from the premises in the following circumstances:
 - If an intoxicated or otherwise prohibited person under the Act.
- i) Alcohol may only be served in the following containers:
 - Beer shall be by way of beer handles as supplied by the premises or single serve 330ml bottles or 750ml shared bottles.
 - Wine and spirits shall be by way of single serve glassware as supplied by the premises.
 - Pre-mixes/RTD's shall be by way of single serve 330ml bottles.
