Decision (on the papers)

This is an application for the renewal of a club licence to The Dargaville Rugby and Sports Club Incorporated in respect of premises situated at 55 Murdoch Street, Dargaville, Kaipara District known as “Dargaville Rugby and Sports Club”.

This application has been made under s.127 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and is determined by the District Licencing Committee under s.130 of the Act.

There are no changes sought to the conditions of the existing licence.



A copy of the application was provided to the Licensing Inspector, Police and the Medical Officer of Health for reporting in accordance with s.129 of the Act. No matters in opposition have been raised in reports supplied by the agencies, other than request by the Medical Officer of Health and recommendation by the Inspector that a standard food condition be imposed on the replacement licence. No matters of opposition or desire to be heard have been received by members of the public.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in ss.105 and 131 of the Act and we grant the application for renewal of a club licence under s.202 (1).

The existing licence is deemed to be current under s.122 of the Act.

We renew the licence until 23 July 2020 pursuant to s.135 (1) of the Act that being three years from the anniversary date of the licence and authorise the issue of a replacement licence and a notice of renewal.

The licensee's attention is drawn to the condition of replacement licence 03/CL/004/2017 to ensure that potable drinking water is readily available and free of charge to customers at all times that the licensed premises are open for business. Signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.

The licensee's attention is drawn to s.53 of the Act for the holder of a club licence to ensure that, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of food is available for sale and consumption on the premises, in portions for a single customer, -

- (a) at reasonable prices; and
- (b) within a reasonable time of being ordered
