DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application for a manager's certificate by Lowri Elizabeth Evans.

The District Licensing Committee notes that the applicant is working in the licensed premises known as known as Paparua Hotel, situated at 2039 Paparua Valley Road, Paparua, Kaipara District.

This application was made under s.219 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and determined by the District Licensing Committee under s. 221 of the Act.

The application was referred to the Police and Inspector for comment. The Police have no objection to the application. With regard to concerns raised in the Inspectors report and recommendation for a further 6 months' work experience during busy or high risk trading hours, I am satisfied that this has been addressed by the provision of a signed undertaking by the applicant effectively restricting her from working as a duty manager from 4.00pm any Thursday to 12.00 midnight any Saturday for a further period of 6 months.

Notwithstanding the concern addressed through the undertaking, no other matters in opposition have been raised in respect of the applicant.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.220 and 222 of the Act. Subject to the condition of the undertaking I grant the issuing of a Managers certificate under s.202(1).

The managers certificate 03/CERT/033/2017 may be issued immediately.
