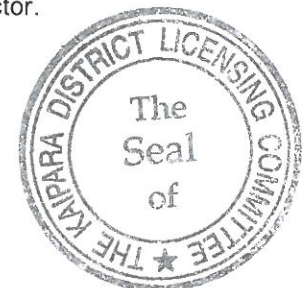
Decision (On the Papers)

This is for an application for the renewal and variation of an Off licence to Wikaira Tui Limited situated at 3065 State Highway 12, Kaihu, Kaipara District known as "Kaihu Tavern".

The application was made under ss.120 and 127 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and determined by the District Licensing Committee under ss.104 and 130 of the Act.

The applicant seeks a variation to the conditions of the existing licence removing the restricted designation from the public bar to allow the whole of the premises to be designated as a supervised area.

No objections to the application for renewal and variation nor any notice of desire to be heard have been received from the Police, the Medical Officer Health or the Licensing Inspector.



Public Notification of the application featured in the Kaipara Lifestyler on 27 June 2017 and on 04 July 2017, thus satisfying the requirement of s.120 and 127 of the Act. No objection or notice of desire to be heard was received by the Territorial Authority.


The existing licence is deemed to be current under s.122 of the Act.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in ss.105 and 131 of the Act and we grant the renewal and variation of the Off licence under s.202(1).

We renew the Off licence until 05 July 2020 pursuant to s.135(1) of the Act, that being three years from the anniversary date of the licence and authorise the issue of a replacement licence and a notice of renewal.

The licensee's attention is also drawn to the condition of replacement licence 03/OFF/007/2017 to ensure that drinking water is readily available and free of charge to customers at all times that the licensed premises are offering complimentary tastings of alcohol. Signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.
