DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application for the renewal of a bottle store style off licence by Adams Family Enterprises Limited, in respect of premises situated at Shop 1, 41 Moir Street, Mangawhai, Kaipara District and known as “Village Liquor.

The application has been made under s.127 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and must be determined by the District Licensing Committee under s.130 of the Act.

No objections to the application for renewal nor any notice of desire to be heard have been received from the Police, the Medical Officer Health or the Licensing Inspector.

Public Notification of the application featured in the Northern Advocate on 12 August and 19 August 2017, thus satisfying the requirement of s.127 of the Act. No objection or notice of desire to be heard was received by the Territorial Authority.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and we grant the renewal of the off licence under s.202(1).

The existing licence is deemed to be current under s.122 of the Act.

We renew the off licence until 20th day of September 2020 pursuant to s.135(1) of the Act, that being three years from the first anniversary date of the licence and authorise the issue of a replacement licence and a notice of renewal.

The licensee’s attention is also drawn to the condition of replacement off licence 03/OFF/011/2017 to ensure that drinking water is readily available and free of charge to customers at all times that the licensed premises are offering complimentary tastings of alcohol. Signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.
