Decision (On the Papers)

This is for an application for the renewal of an On licence by Bennetts of Mangawhai Limited in respect of premises situated at 52 Moir Street, Mangawhai, Kaipara District known as “Café Cadenet”.

This application has been made under s.127 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and is determined by the District Licencing Committee under s.130 of the Act.

There are no changes sought to the conditions of the existing licence.

A copy of the application was provided to the Licensing Inspector, Police and the Medical Officer of Health for reporting in accordance with s.129. No matters in opposition have been raised in reports supplied by the agencies.



The application was filed with the Territorial Authority on 10 May 2017 however public notification did not take place until 21 June 2017, which does not satisfy the requirement of Section 127 of the Act.

Section 208 of the Act allows the licensing committee or chairperson to waive certain omissions if satisfied that the neglect or omission was not wilful; a waiver may be applied on such terms as are considered equitable.

As no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received with regard to this application, I am prepared to waive the errors in advertising pursuant to section 208 of the Act. In my opinion no one has been disadvantaged by the error in the public notification. Accordingly I deal with the matter on the papers.


I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in ss.105 and 131 of the Act and I grant the renewal of the On licence under s.202(1).

The existing licence is deemed to be current under s.122 of the Act.

I renew the licence until 30 May 2020 pursuant to s.135 (1) of the Act, that being three years from the first anniversary date of the licence and authorise the issue of a replacement licence and a notice of renewal.

The licensee's attention is drawn to the condition of replacement licence 03/CL/009/2017 to ensure that potable drinking water is readily available and free of charge to customers at all times that the licensed premises are open for business. Signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.
