## **ON-LICENCE**

Sections 14 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), <u>PAULA LINNEA VAN DEN BERG</u> (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **10 Ruawai Wharf Road, Ruawai, Kaipara District** and known as **Ruawai Steakhouse Restaurant and Pizza Bar** to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

## **CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not present on the premises to dine.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours: On such days and during such hours as the premises are being operated as a restaurant but not other than on the following days and hours:

  Monday to Sunday.

  11.00 am to 1.00 am the following day.
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol. "Freely available" to customers in relation to water means -
  - (i) supplied free in clean drinking vessels on request; or
  - (ii) Available free in larger containers from which it may be easily poured or drawn by customers, together with clean drinking vessels that are also available free nearby; or
  - (iii) Available free from a tap to which customers have easy access, together with clean drinking water vessels that are also available free nearby.
- (d) The fees payable for the licensing of the premises concerned are the following risk rating: low.
- (e) The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
  - (i) The licensee must ensure that all staff comply with the host responsibility plan submitted with the application for an on-licence detailing the steps to be taken by the licensee to ensure a safe drinking environment.
- (f) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
  - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons adjacent to every point of sale.
- (g) The entire premises is designated as a supervised area.

## <u>DURATION</u>

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
  - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
  - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or

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(ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
