DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Nicola Madeline Deveraux for the renewal and variation of a winery style off licence in respect of premises situated at 367 King Road Mangawhai, Kaipara District and known as “Te Whai Bay Wines”.

In terms of the variation sought, the applicant is seeking an endorsement under section 40 of the Act to allow remote sales.

Public notification appeared in the Northern Advocate on 14 November 2020, which omitted to reference the variation. As no objection of desire to be heard was received by the Territorial Authority I am prepared to waive the omission pursuant to s.208 of the Act.

Accordingly, I shall deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in sections 120 & 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. I renew the licence until 5th day of February 2024, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry and authorise the issue of a notice of renewal and replacement licence 03/OFF/014/2020 incorporating such new conditions as required to meet the requirements of the Act and Regulations.
