DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Brenda Jackson and Paul Thomas Jackson for variation and renewal of a hotel style on licence in respect of premises situated at 18-22 Victoria Street, Dargaville, Kaipara District and known as “Dargaville Central Hotel”.

In terms of the variation sought, the applicant is seeking a variation of two of the conditions of the existing on-licence. In particular

- Variation is sought to condition (b) for the purpose of extending the existing permitted trading hours; and,
- Variation is sought to condition (g) for the purpose of redefining the designation of the public bar and gaming room to a restricted designation.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly, I shall deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in sections 120 & 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. I renew the licence until 15th day of October 2024, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry and authorise the issue of a notice of renewal and replacement licence 03/ON/002/2022 incorporating such new conditions as required to meet the requirements of the Act and Regulations.
