**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Nicola Madeline Deveraux for variation and renewal of a winery style on licence in respect of premises situated at 367 King Road, Molesworth, Kaipara District and known as “Te Whai Bay Wines”.

In terms of the variation sought, the applicant is seeking the following variation:

- (i) Vary the licensed premises footprint which are identified in a plan date stamped as received by the Kaipara District Licensing Agency on 26 May 2016.
- (ii) Remove condition c from on licence 03/ON/012/2020.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly, I shall deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in sections 120 & 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. I renew the licence until 13th day of October 2025, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry and authorise the issue of a notice of renewal and replacement licence 03/ON/013/2022 incorporating such new conditions as required to meet the requirements of the Act and Regulations.
