DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by the partnership of VtV Partners for variation and renewal of a cafe style on licence in respect of premises situated at 1955 State Highway One, Kaiwaka, Kaipara District and known as “Eutopia Cafe”.

In terms of the variation sought, the applicant is seeking the following variation:

The applicant seeks to change from a class 2 restaurant to a class 1 restaurant.

The application was duly advertised on 5 April 2022 and 12 April 2022 with regards to the renewal of the application but omitted to advertise the variation sought. As no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received I am prepared to waiver the error in advertisement pursuant to Section 208 of the Act. In my opinion no one has been disadvantaged by the advertisement error.

Accordingly, I shall deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in sections 120 & 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. I renew the licence until 9th day of April 2025, that being three years from the anniversary of the licence and authorise the issue of a notice of renewal and replacement licence 03/ON/005/2022 incorporating such new conditions as required to meet the requirements of the Act and Regulations.
