

**Special Licence (for Premises.)**

**03/SP/2174/2024A**

Sections 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Maungaturoto Memorial RSA Incorporated** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol for consumption on the premises situated at 115 Hurndall Street East, Maungaturoto, Kaipara District and known as Maungaturoto Memorial RSA to any person attending the following occasion or event:

**Mic night fundraiser for maintenance of building.**

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act. For the purpose of this licence, Robin Thomas Weatherhog, Graeme William Bond and Terrence James McCook shall be appointed by the licensee.

**CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:

Friday 16 May 2025 - 5.00pm to 12.00 midnight.

- b) The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments.
- c) A minimum of three substantial food options shall be available at all times that the special licence is in force. The range of food shall be similar to that shown on any menu submitted or a range of food in the nature of pies, sandwiches, filled rolls, pizza and the like.
- d) Low-alcohol beverages of the nature stated on the application form, must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times when the premises are authorised to be open for the sale of alcohol.
- e) Drinking water be freely available to all customers at all times that the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.  
'Freely available' to customers, in relation to water, means -
  - (i) Supplied free in clean drinking vessels on request; or
  - (ii) Available free in larger containers from which it may be easily poured or drawn by customers, together with clean drinking vessels that are also available free nearby; or
  - (iii) Available free from a tap to which customers have easy access, together with clean drinking vessels that are also available free nearby.
- f) The steps detailed in the application form must be taken by the licensee to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the licensed premises.
- g) The steps as detailed in the application form must be taken by the licensee to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol.
- h) The following steps shall be taken by the licensee to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - (i) A certificated manager is to be on duty at all times.
  - (ii) Host responsibility techniques to be applied to ensure no intoxication.
  - (iii) No sale of alcohol to minors or intoxicated persons allowed.
- i) Members of the public shall be excluded from the premises in the following circumstances:
  - (i) If an intoxicated or otherwise prohibited person under the Act.
- j) Alcohol may only be served in the following containers:
  - (i) Beer shall be by way of single 330ml or 750ml bottle.
  - (i) Wine shall be by way of single serve 150ml glass.
  - (ii) Spirits shall be by way of single serve 15 ml nip.
  - (iii) RTDs shall be by way of single serve 330ml bottle.

**DURATION**

This licence is in force on the date and between the times listed in condition a) above.
