DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Haezal Enterprise Limited for the variation and renewal of a grocery style off licence in respect of premises situated at 2024 Paparua Valley Road, Paparua, Kaipara District and known as “Paparua Store”.

In terms of the variation sought, the applicant is seeking the following variation:

The applicant seeks to change the hours that alcohol may be sold.

Current condition (b): Monday to Sunday – 9.00am to 8.00pm.

New condition (b): Monday to Sunday – 7.00am to 9.00pm.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly, I shall deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in sections 120 & 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. I renew the licence until 4th day of February 2029, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry and authorise the issue of a notice of renewal and replacement licence 03/OFF/002/2026 incorporating such new conditions as required to meet the requirements of the Act and Regulations.
