**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This was a late application by **Nicola Madeline Deveraux** for both an on and off-site special licence.

The nature of the event is a series of Music in the Vines events to be held on Saturdays from 3.00pm to 7.00pm.

The applicant proposes to sell wine and beer for consumption on site and 750ml unopened wine bottles for consumption off the premises. The applicant has stated in the application that attendees may collect the wine bottle(s) when leaving the event.

The applicant has held both an on and off licence and has been granted several special licences for similar events and festivals historically.

There being no matters raised in opposition to this application, I shall deal with the matters on the papers.

As the reporting agencies agreed to process the application, I gave careful consideration to reasons for lateness of the application and came to the view that I was satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act, and I grant the applicant a special licence.

A copy of special licence 03/SP/2315/2026 setting out the conditions to which it is subject is attached to this decision. The licence may issue immediately.
