

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Terms and Conditions

When purchasing a plot, you are in fact purchasing exclusive right of interment and not the land itself, this remains the property of Kaipara District Council.

Exclusive right of interment expires after 60 years if the plot has not had an interment take place. If a burial/interment has not taken place in that plot within that time, Kaipara District Council reserves the right to revoke the Exclusive Right of Interment in accordance with the Burials and Cremation Act 1964.

All fees must be paid in full before a burial can take place. Council does not offer a credit facility to private individuals. Payment can be made in person at any Council Service Centre or by internet banking.

Only Council or its representative is authorised to dig a grave or ash plot.

Adornments, including all wreaths and floral tributes may be placed on a plot for up to 30 days following an interment. After this time, all adornments will be relocated to the concrete beam or transferred to the Tribute Pick up Area and marked with the name of the interred person/s. A note will be placed at the plot advising family of this. Any adornments added after this time must be confined to approved receptacles, or the concrete berm.
