

Archaeological recorded sites in the vicinity of Private Plan Change 83



The orange polygon is the approximate area of Private plan change 83.

Please note the red dot refers to recorded archaeological sites. The dot shows location but not the extent of each site.

Comment

The mostly undamaged archaeology to the north contains a high number of archaeology sites. This probably represents the standard survival of archaeology in a low damage rural environment

The smaller number of sites to the south probably reflects lower survival of archaeology due to more earthworks occurring in urban development.

The plan change area and the land east of it going through to the coast has not been surveyed by an archaeologist and this probably reflects the lack of recorded sites here.
