## This is a submission on Private Plan Change 85 - Mangawhai East.

Private plan change number: PPC85 | Private plan change name: Mangawhai East

Submissions must be received by 5pm on Monday 18 August 2025.



The purpose of the plan change is to:

- **a.** Rezone approximately 94 hectares of rural zoned land within the Mangawhai Harbour overlay to a mix of residential and commercial zoned land as follows:
  - Large Lot Residential 6.3 ha
  - Low Density Residential 45.5 ha
  - o Medium Density Residential 12.5 ha
  - Neighbourhood Centre 2.7 ha
  - Mixed Use 2.2 ha
  - o Rural Lifestyle 24.7 ha

Total Area = 94 ha

**b.** Create a Development Area containing a suite of planning provisions to control and manage subdivision, use and development within the Plan change area.

- **c.** Apply a Coastal Hazard overlay over the land area identified to be potentially subject to coastal hazard where the effects of potential mitigation measures will need to be managed.
- d. Include Ecological features maps to convey areas of ecological sensitivity for future protection.
- **e.** Incorporate a Structure Plan into the Development Area to visually depict key features and outcomes required.
- f. Make any necessary consequential amendments to the Kaipara District Plan Maps.

I have owned a property at Mangawhai Heads for nearly 25 years, and over that period have noticed the incredible growth of the greater Mangawhai area. In recent years this growth rate has stepped up to a new level, starting with the Mangawhai Central development, and this is putting immense pressure on the local infrastructure. We currently have new subdivisions at Mangawhai Central, Cove Rd, Cullen St, plus many smaller fill in lots. These alone once built and occupied will stretch local infrastructure to the limit, being roading, wastewater, plus the main access roads. Also the delicate Mangawahi Estuary and bird sanctuary will be put under more pressure.

The KDC has identified future development in the Mangawhai Spatial Plan (MPS) and PPC 83 and PPC84 in what I think is a manageable plan.

PPC85 is not consistent with the MSP, and if it were to be accepted and implemented, it would set a precedent that the KDC will allow unlimited development anywhere within their boundaries and that any land owner can do subdivision.

Also it goes completely against decades of work to preserve the estuary and bird sanctuary with the

amount of estuary foreshore in the plan.

The KDC current decision makers will be long gone when the full detrimental effects of PPC85 are realized down the track, so it is the responsibility of the current council to say no to PPC85 and make a stand. Come on KDC, stand up and be counted and listen to your community and don't be swayed but a small group of individuals wanting to cash up and the expense of the wider community. Stick with the current MSP and PPC83 and PPC84 and put your foot down and show us why we elected you.
