I am opposed to the whole of PPC85

Mangawhai Spatial Plan for growth area "G"

Intensified development pattern is not to be sought.

Regarding land "o" and "p"

This area/land is very close to the beach, estuary and sand dunes and the overflow of this development and its construction would effect permanently the very areas that attract people to Mangawhai. Clear waters, facilities for water recreation and sand dunes (A bird refuge area).

The land is close to the highway to Auckland and road congestion would be a major problem .

Regarding land "q"

This area is highly restrained due to the risk of sea level rise, coastal hazards and ecological protection. This area is relatively flat and intensive building would increase the risk of flooding and permanent damage to Mangawhai's already delicate infrastructure systems.

While there may be many reasons for this development, it is too premature. It seems to me that development occurs without full consideration of the future infrastructure systems and these been tested and functional in other existing urban MSP developments. Its too early to see as these are not yet completed.

I oppose the whole of PPC85 because the application is incomplete in setting out in detail all public/shared infrastructure needed to protect the area of Mangawhai that would allow an environment for future generations can enjoy.
