

RETURN OF ELECTORAL DONATIONS AND EXPENSES

- the name of the contributor;
- the address of the contributor;
- the total amount of the contributor's contributions made in relation to the election.

NB: Section 103(4) Local Electoral Act 2001 defines "contributions" as money or goods or services that have been given to a person or fund, be applied to, or included in an electoral donation (for example, contributions to trust funds or a fundraising collection).

PART B: RETURN OF ELECTORAL EXPENSES (inclusive of GST)

Set out the following details in respect of every electoral expense incurred by or on behalf of the candidate at the election in respect of any electoral activity:

- the name and description of every person or body of persons to whom any sum was paid,
- the reason that sum was paid.
