5.2 Road Stopping and Legalisation Central Road, Taipuha

The proposed sections of road to be stopped are approximately 18,768m² with 11,185 m² to be legalised, located (Lot 1 DP 25706 & Allt 381 Psh of Mareretu) approximately 8km into Central Road, Taipuha generally as shown on Attachment 2 annexed to the above-mentioned report. There is a further 13,260m² of formed road in this immediate area (Allot 393 Psh of Mareretu and Lot 1 DP 97520) that requires legalisation generally as shown on Attachment 3 annexed to the above-mentioned report. This is additional to application and would be an expense to Council.
