Though some progress has been made, there has been pause in the completion of the Park Info sign, the Te Uri o Hau story panels and one set of brand posts. This is due to consideration taken for funds being sought from the Provincial Growth Fund - monies that would affect the visuals at the entrance to the Pa and the use of the Pa. We should know the outcome of that EOI within the next 2 months. The story panels can then be finalised and the approvals sought by the Taumata Council for installation completion by June 2019. We are seeking recommendation that the currently allocated funding of \$23,800.- is carried over into the next financial year of 2018-19.
