key features

- Natural water bodies and associated viewsheds

- Built structures

- Access to open coastline

key issues

- Protection of a significant local and district landscape
- Provision for ongoing beach access
- Ongoing degradation of natural Dune systems
- Effectively and safely managing the conflicts between pedestrians, car parking and traffic movements
- Car parking provision and design e.g., providing sufficient overflow car parking for peak seasonal demands
- Increased demand and higher rates of use on existing roading network.
- Provision for emergency services access
- Appropriate access to The Heads lookout area
- Provision of services and concessionaires.
- The relocation of the existing toilet block to a less dominant location
- The rehabilitation of existing grassed areas and surrounding vegetation and provision of adequate shaded open space
- Increased provision of access ways from residential areas
