Residents of Tawa Ave are responsible for the upkeep of the private part of the road.

There exists tension between the road owner (113 Tawa Ave) and many of the residents on the road who have ROW. I have been informed that the road owner has signed emails to some residents with 'Its my road you can f**k off'.

These ongoing tensions have contributed to my husband's ill health, and we anticipate with a high level of certainty things will only get worse with a school at the end of the road.

It is not unreasonable to predict that staff and parents will use the private part of Tawa Road for access and parking when the school has events, or on a daily basis. We don't want the pressure, responsibility, or worry of what may happen if school members/parents use the road.

The council has allowed for many sub divisions on the road, which is more traffic, and now it is proposing a school to be built, which will put significant pressure on every resident on all of Tawa Road, not just those in the immediate vicinity of the school.

In planning for the Kura the council and Ministry need to improve the wider infrastructure (facilities and services), not just the immediate area around the school.

We, residents of Tawa Road, want our rubbish collected from our gates and the private portion of the road made public (owned by council) for the safety and well-being of all, this is necessary for council and the ministry to meet the requirements of the safety act.

As residents on Tawa Road, we cannot take much more.
