

RM230077 Hearing 21st and 22nd November 2023

Resource Consent Application – Ministry of Education – 9 Tawa Avenue, Kaiwaka – Notice of requirement to designate land for Educational Purposes to enable the relocation of Te Kura Kaupapa Māori O Ngaringaomatariki and to enable the use of the site as a Kura Kaupapa Māori for years 0-13, and a Puna Reo - Kaipara District Council Hearing

The above application will be heard by Hearing Commissioner Bill Smith at a hearing to be held as follows:

- Date: 21st and 22nd November 2023
- Time: 9.00am
- Venue: Kaiwaka Sports Centre 2 Gibbons Road, Kaiwaka.

Pursuant to section 103B of the Resource Management Act 1991, the pre-provision of evidence is <u>mandatory</u>. The following apply:

The Council is required to provide its officer's reports and any evidence at least fifteen (15) working days before the hearing. This is required no later than 30th October 2023.

The applicant is required to provide all its briefs of evidence at least ten (10) working days before the hearing. This evidence is required no later than 6th November 2023.

The applicant is required to provide:

- 6 hard copies of the evidence
- 1 soft copy briefs of evidence to be provided via email or on a data stick.

Any submitter proposing to call expert witnesses is required to provide briefs of evidence from those experts by email to the Technical Support Officer at <u>rmanotified@kaipara.govt.nz</u> at least five (5) working days before the hearing. Expert evidence will be required by 13th November 2023.

The expert witness is required to provide:

- 6 hard copies of the evidence
- 1 soft copy briefs of evidence to be provided via email or on a data stick



(a) The Council and the applicant are required to provide all evidence prior to the hearing. The submitters are required to provide any expert evidence before the hearing but can provide non-expert evidence (i.e. personal submissions) at the hearing. These dates are the minimum requirements; receiving the evidence as soon as possible will ensure a more efficient and informed hearings process.

Any submitter who is not proposing to call experts and is intending to read written evidence at the hearing needs to provide at least 5 copies on the day of the hearing.

All evidence and material provided to the Council will be available to view on the Council Website.
